Which estimate applies?

Standard covers qualifying replacement, added-space, heating-without-controls, or cooling-only projects. Energy Optimization applies when qualifying equipment displaces or properly integrates with primary heat.

* Enhanced eligibility must be verified. Energize CT confirms final tonnage, QPL status, and payment.

Check eligibility before purchasing

The project must meet these requirements

- Residential Eversource or UI electric customer
- Equipment installed January 1-December 31, 2026
- Model currently listed on the Energize CT HPQPL
- Energize CT Heat Pump Installer Network contractor
- Installation in a participating utility service territory

How to claim the rebate

- 01 Choose the applicable pathway
- 02 Pre-verify when required
- 03 Install qualified equipment
- 04 Apply with the final paid invoice

Enhanced incentive

Up to \$1,500 per ton for verified income eligibility or electric-resistance replacement.

Electric-resistance replacement must be verified before installation.

Projects may be inspected; final payment is determined by Energize Connecticut.
